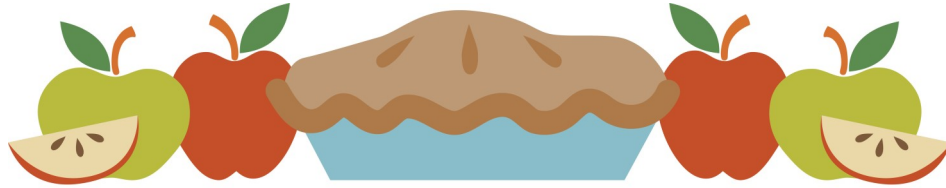
Summer faith practices
